•The Meet the Board Event was held in Labrador/Newfoundland last year and it was a success. It truly personalized WSO to the fellowship. July 25th 2015 is the next Meet the Board Event and it will be held in Nisku Canada. They are now taking bids for 2016 for a Meet the Board in October of 2016. As an Area I would like to know how many people are interested and should I put in a bid? Discuss it with your groups and let your DR know for August 1st.

•The two International Conventions were discussed. 1) The AA International Convention with Al-Anon participation will be in Atlanta Georgia July 2-5, 2015. There's always walk -in registration if you didn't pre-register. There are 40,000 people pre-registered. 2) The Al-Anon International Convention will be held in Baltimore Maryland July 5-8th 2018.

•Since 2011 Memorial Contributions have been discussed and have been brought back to Conference to further solidify a new policy. There was a decision on self defining member/family so some progress has been made. Now the Conference would like to set a limit of the amount of money that can be given at one time. It has been suggested 1-10% for non-members to contribute. It will go back to the policy committee and back to conference next year. It is always suggested that non-members may buy literature and to give it to libraries or the other groups.

•Then there was the budget discussion. The bulk of the budget has to do with employees and their benefits like most corporations on the expense side. On the income side it is again group contributions and the sale of literature. WSO though is not a clearing house and we can't always rely on the sale of literature. The focus of course is on group contributions. Contributions are up 8.2% but as a Conference we still approved a budget with a \$52,000 shortfall. It is suggested that each registered group contribute \$252/year.

- •Connecticut donated a total of \$24,442 last year with 63.9% of groups contributing.
- •The reserve fund at WSO right now is less than a year's operating expense because WSO has borrowed from this fund and there aren't funds to replace it.
- •WSO assures us with this budget deficit there will be no services cut for the members and again we can't rely on WSO just selling literature.

•Each year there are Areas that are to elect a Regional Trustee. At this time the Northeast is looking for a Regional Trustee. The process is very similar to our Board of Directors nominations where the nominee goes before his/her group, district and then the Assembly to get a vote of confidence from the members. It is then sent to the Delegates of the Northeast and it is scored and then sent to the nominating committee at WSO. All the Delegates from the Northeast plus two from outside the area are part of the process to select a new Regional Trustee.


Balance






Alateen Chat Safety

•There was a report from IAGSM2014 (International Al-Anon General Services Meeting) was held here in Virginia Beach with fewer countries present for the meeting due to financial, language issues and travel issues. The summary of the meeting can be found on the member website. We did have visitors from Germany, Eirn/United Kingdom and Mexico and their stories of recovery were very similar to yours and mine. So it truly is a world wide fellowship. In 2016 the IAGSM will be held in Rome, Italy.
