- You and Your Board Connect was held in Cleveland, Ohio on October 29, 2022. I was fortunate to attend this event with some of my fellow Panel 60 Delegates. - WSO is working on how and what would be needed to upgrade their current database to be able to list electronic meetings which are connected to Geographic Areas on al-anon.org. As a result, WSO has created a Task Force which consisting of WSO staff, Area Group Records Coordinators and District Representatives and are continuing to work on it. More to be revealed.
- To date, Eighteen Areas have decided to accept Permanent Electronic Meetings into their Service Structure.
