- Currently only 30% of our Districts have PO Coordinators
- Another 47% of Public Outreach participation comes from our truly supportive DR's and Alternate DR's. Thank you!
- Our total Public Outreach coverage for Connecticut is 77%
- In 2020 our goal is to have PO participation from all Districts. 9 PO Coordinators are needed.
