



District 5 Comes Alive in its PO Initiatives

In the early Spring of 2011, District 5 created a Spanish liaison position. The idea of a Spanish liaison was born at a District 5 meeting of the GR's from a very real situation: The Norwalk Spanish GR indicated that we had to find a new meeting place for the Stamford Spanish group because people in Stamford were too afraid to go to the neighborhood where the meeting was held and there was only one woman holding the fort every week in Stamford. This same woman was opening the door of the Stamford meeting and running the meeting all by herself for about a year and her wish was to find a new location in Stamford where more Spanish-speaking Al-Anon members would come every week. During that same meeting, another GR volunteered to step up as Spanish Liaison to coordinate efforts between the English and the Spanish Al-Anon groups and also to support the Spanish Al-Anon community at the District level. And, to show that you are not alone in Al-Anon, another GR offered at that same meeting to contact a church minister about the possibility of hosting the Spanish Al-Anon group. It all came together as a miracle: the church agreed to charge minimal rent for



a lovely meeting space inside the church in a very safe part of Stamford. We moved the location of the meeting and that first night had more than 10 Spanish Speaking Al-Anon members show up to share their experience, strength and hope. Since then, the Stamford Spanish meeting has been attended by several grateful Al-Anon members.

The Spanish liaison reached out to the Norwalk Spanishspeaking group as well and one woman in this group had a dream: her dream was to organize an Al-Anon public outreach day at the Norwalk High School. Since she does not speak English, the liaison contacted the school and met with the guidance counselor who agreed to organize an Al-Anon Awareness day on October 18th, 2011. On that day, the public outreach presentations will be held both in English and in Spanish for the students in the morning and the parents in the evening. Many grateful Al-Anon members have stepped up to volunteer to speak at the Norwalk High School and it goes to show that you are never alone in Al-Anon.

Convention Thought Force Results

The Convention Thought Force has been meeting through the spring and summer to determine if we could make improvements to our Convention to attract more people. They put out a survey and received 185 responses. Some respondents had not attended a Convention, some had attended a few and some had attended many. Most respondents who had not attended said it was because they were new or had scheduling conflicts. Most who had attended liked the fellowship and the Al-Anon and keynote speakers best.

Most had heard about it at a meeting. They liked the central location. Most respondents said it was a good value although some thought it was too expensive. They were



split on a meal plan but most liked spring as a Convention time. The majority of the respondents were from the center of the state and the majority stayed the weekend. They varied from less than a year to more than 20 years in the program. So the result seems to be that we're doing OK.
